

# Island Communities Prepared For Remembrance Day Services

Thousands of members of the Royal Canadian Legion representing branches in more than 20 Prince Edward Island communities will pay tribute to the dead of two world wars and the Korean conflict Monday — Remembrance Day — at memorial services across the island.

The Remembrance Day parade will fall in at the Legion Home at 10:30 a.m. from where it will move to the Cenotaph. The band of the P.E.I. Regiment will attend.

The Last Post will be sounded followed by a reading by branch president Freeman Miles. The Last Post will be sounded.

The Roman Catholic padre will offer the prayer and the Protestant padre giving the sermon.

Selections by the band of the P.E.I. Regiment will be heard during the playing of the wreaths, followed by a hymn and "God Save the Queen."

The parade route will begin at the Legion Home going along Grafton Street to Queen Street in Kent Street to Great George Street to the Cenotaph. On completion of the service the parade will move off Grafton to Prince Street to Richmond Street where the Lieutenant Governor will offer the salute in front of the Provincial building, then to the Legion Home.
