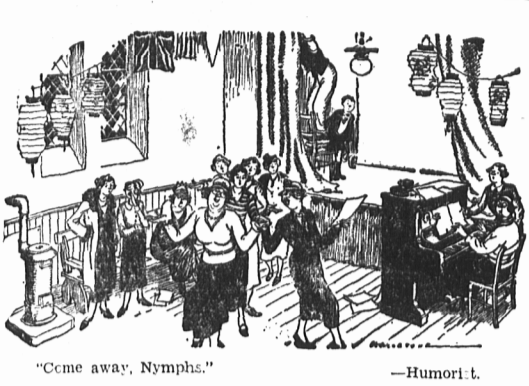

October finished at 58 1-2, November 59 3-4, December 59 5-8-3-4 and May 28 3-4-7-8 cents. Heavy buying shot Liverpool quotations 2 7-8-2d up. Buenos Aires dropped 1 5-8 cents.
