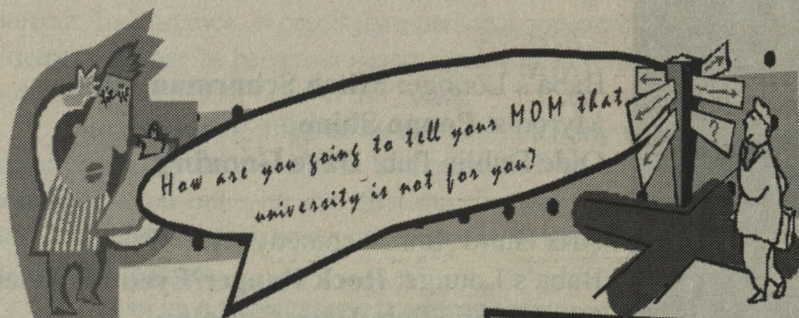
GUIDELINES:

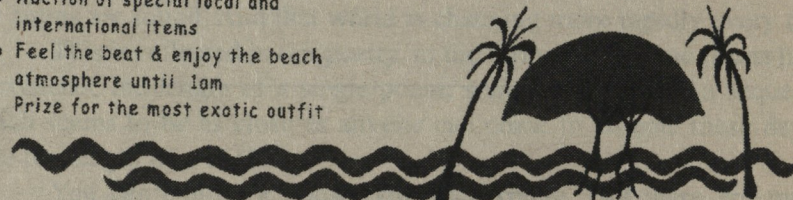

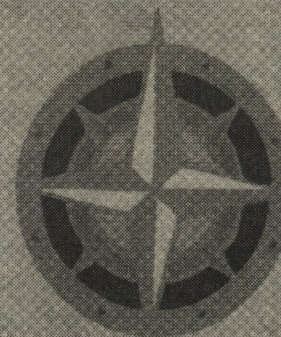
