 Yes, I'd have to make more money to come. Since I only have one year left there's not much you can do about it.



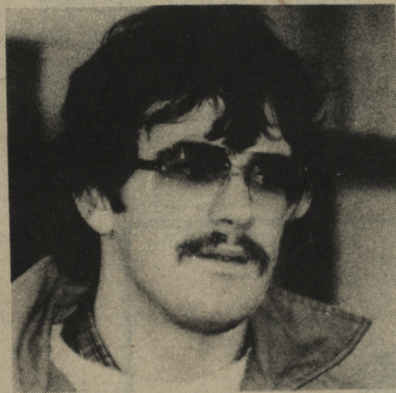
Chris Chivalo - Frosh

 No. I have a scholarship; also a full time summer job.



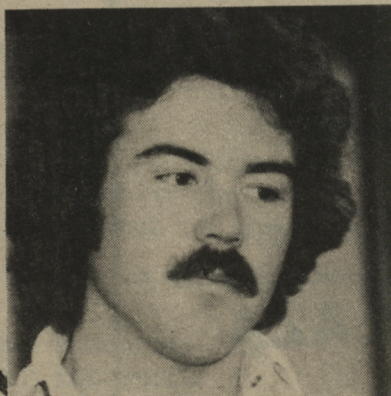
John Fitzpatrick - Junior
