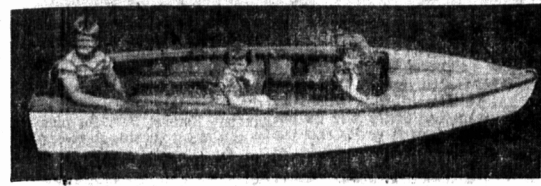

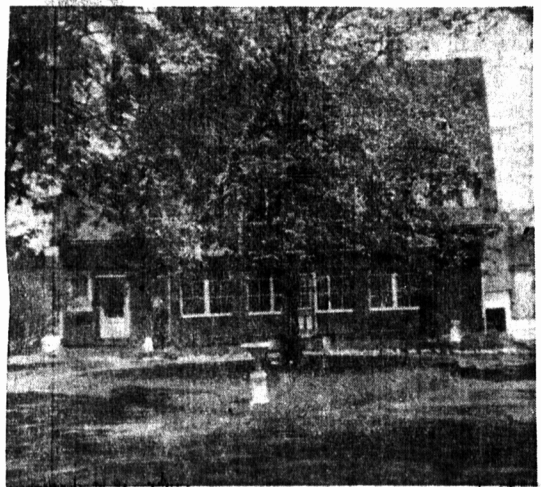

Swine Experiment University Of Alberta

EDMONTON (CP)—A method has been found of making accurate estimates of the amount of backfat on a live pig, a step of considerable value to the swine breeder.

An experiment conducted at the University of Alberta was reported by Dr. J. P. Bowland and Dr. R. T. Berg in the press bulletin of the University's extension department.

Although Alberta is second only to Ontario as the highest hog-producing province, carcass grades of Alberta hogs are the lowest of any province.

The live backfat measurements should prove excellent supplementary information in the selection of breeding stock, says the report.

Measurement of backfat thickness prior to slaughter is made with a lean-meter, a device developed at Purdue University.

The average backfat thickness has been shown to be an excellent indicator of the total amount of fat in the carcass. The Purdue lean-meter is used to distinguish between surface fat and lean tissues on the live hog.

The method is based on the difference between the abilities of fat and muscle to conduct electricity, fat being a poor conductor, and muscle and blood being excellent conductors.

The instrument consists of a slender needle containing electrodes and an indicator which shows whether the point of the needle is in fatty or muscular tissue. A scale measures penetration of the needle in 10ths of an inch. No injury or infection to the pig as a result of the probing was experienced in the experiments.

TO TEST ACCURACY

The object was to test the accuracy of the backfat measures obtained by this system and to estimate the relationship of such figures to standard measurements of the Advanced Registry of the Canadian agriculture department.

It is recognized that selection of breeding stock for a reduction of backfat will be effective and also will result in an improvement in over-all carcass quality.

Live backfat probing is an accurate measure of the average carcass backfat depth, the tests showed, and also is fairly closely associated with other measures of carcass quality.

But for certain carcass quality measures, such as loin area and bacon quality, the breeder will still have to rely on actual carcass cutouts if he wishes to make much improvement.

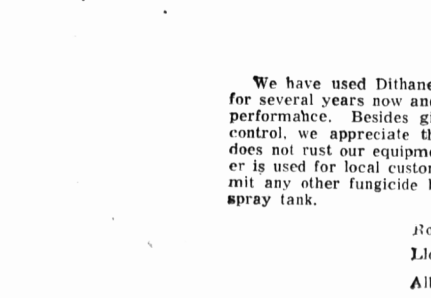
