

MERRY CHRISTMAS FROM THE SUN

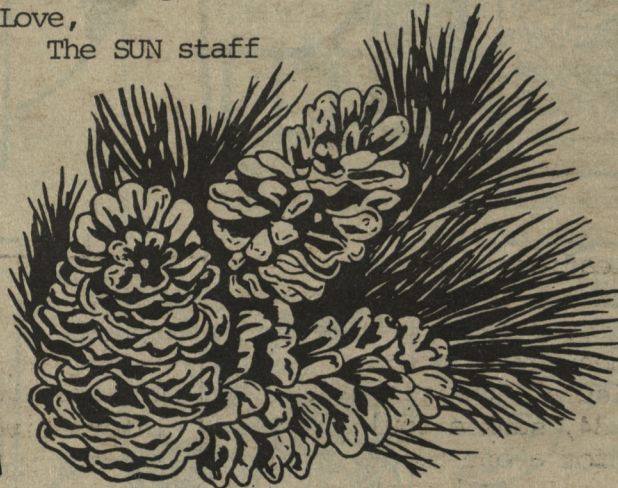


The "Sun" staff would like to take this opportunity to wish students and faculty a very Merry Christmas, a Happy New Year, and relaxing fun filled holidays!

Re: Second Semester Registration: Because of past congestion in the gymnasium, January registration in 1982 will be held as follows:

Registration Steps-
a) Obtain registration form from table, and course cards from Departments Academic Departments, Gymnasium.
b) Pay fees business office.
Duffy Building 209.

c) complete registration Registrar's office, Duffy 210.

Note: Pre-registration students need complete only b) and c).
Scholarship students may skip b) only if they have paid students fees and residence fees (if applicable) in advance.
Times: Full time students Monday, January 4 all day, 9-4:30 p.m.
Part time students Monday, January 4, 7-9 p.m.

Note: Registration of full-time students will run through the noon hour. Department representatives should be on hand all day, and also for the evening registration. Class lists of students who have registered in advance will be available in the Gymnasium early Monday morning or may be picked up at the Registrar's Office on Monday, December 21.

Department representatives should signify permission to take a course by initialing the Course Card.

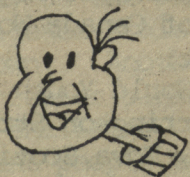
