## SMALL WALKIE-TALKIE COULD BE EXPENSIVE

OTTAWA (CP) — That low-powered walkie-talkie set you bought your kids for Christmas could turn out to be mighty expensive if they misuse it, the federal transport department warned.

A department official said in an interview children have used the sets to misdirect taxis and upset construction work on big projects where walkie-talkies are in common use.

Last summer, a search of Lake Simcoe in Ontario was sparked by a false distress signal sent on a toy set.

The penalty for sending a false distress signal is a fine of up to \$500 or up to one year in jail.

The department warned in a statement that the battery-powered walkie-talkies, a popular item on toy counters this season, "are not toys and their use as playthings constitutes a breach of federal radio regulations."

At the time. He had to choose between taking a heart finesse through West or a club finesse through East by leading the Queen from dummy.

As the cards happened to lie, either finesse was bound to fail. Actually South took the heart finesse and would up going down one for minus 50 points.

The British-North-South pair at the second table also arrived at six diamonds. The bidding went as shown. The declarer, having been offered a free finesse, was extremely happy to accept the gift. He played the jack from dummy and discarded a heart when the jack held the trick. He heart on the ace of clubs, and the outcome was that he made the slam for a score of 920 points.
