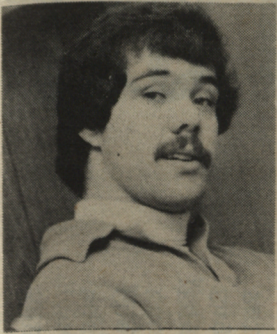

Without a doubt, sports trivia is one of the greatest pastimes for any follower of sports.

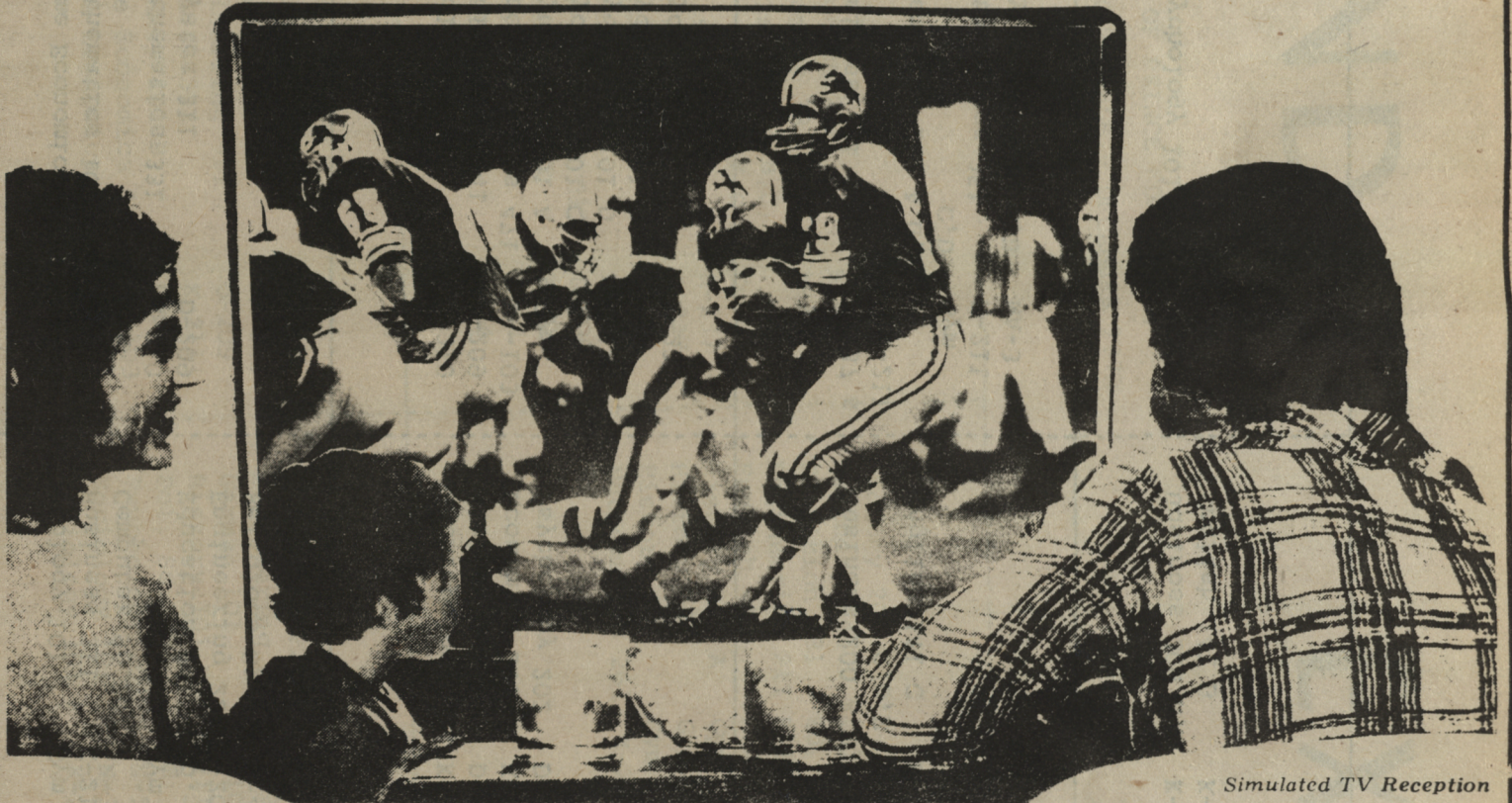
