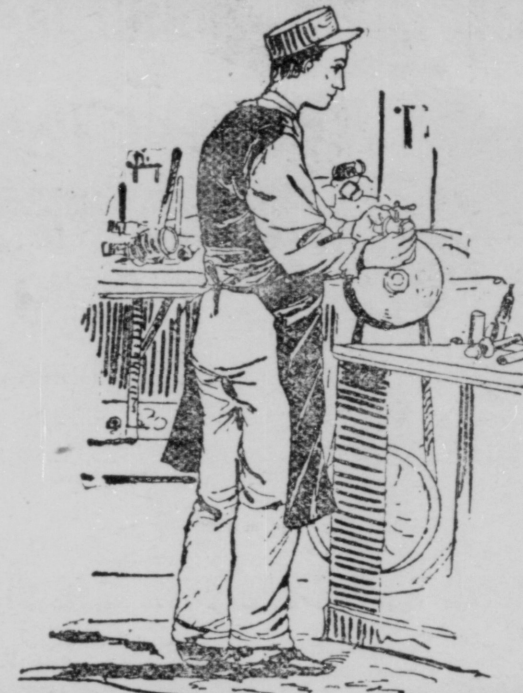
**Don't Worry About the Editor.**

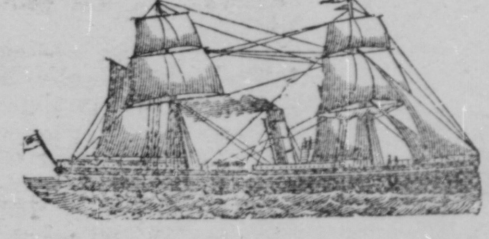
