South could have been considerably more astute. East's double of three diamonds had located the diamond length and strength, hence the markedly correct play at Trick 2 was not a low diamond to the king, but the diamond queen from dummy.

YOUNG REDDY WINS A RACE Who cannot fight should never stay No coward who runs away. —Reddy Fox.

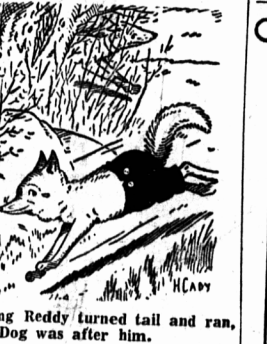

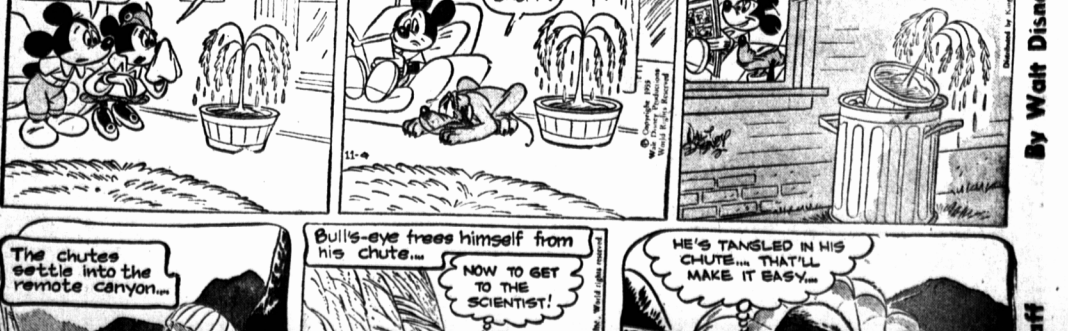
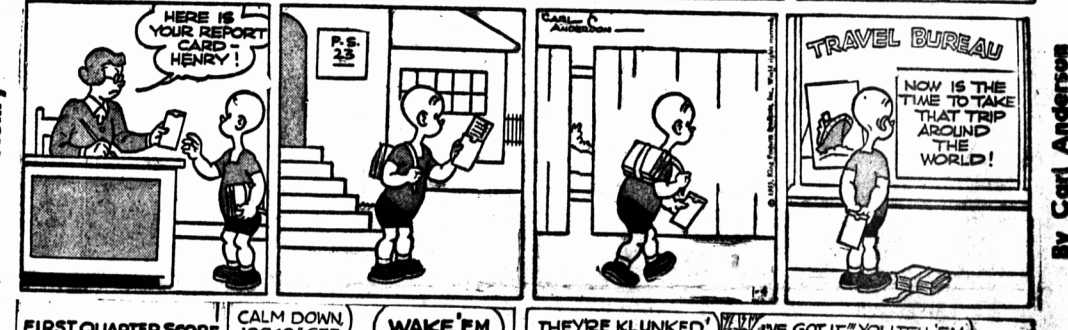
