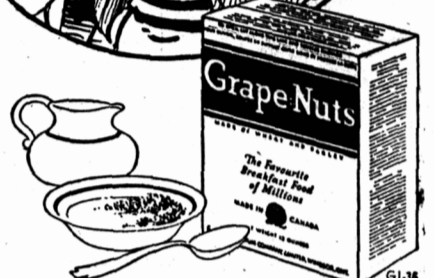

At this time considerable interest is being aroused in ships and shipping by the new super-mammoth liner "Queen Mary," which will soon make her appearance on this side of the Atlantic on her maiden voyage.

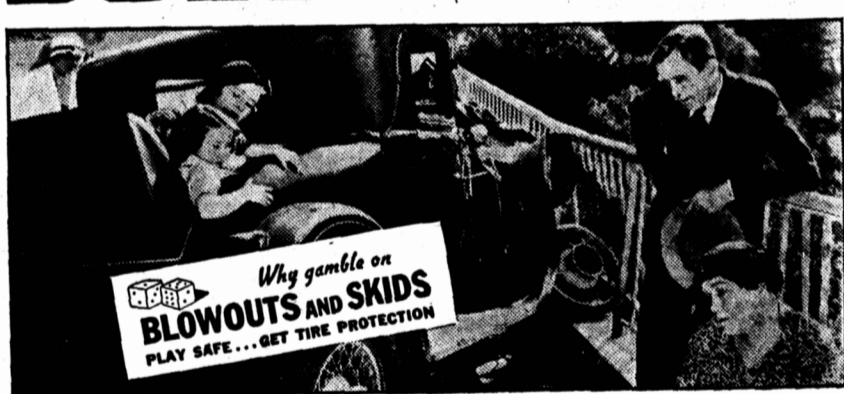
