Over the Christmas holidays, while the Barn was closed for business, a U.P.E.I. security guard, Allan Gillis, was apprehended by the Charlottetown Police for break, enter, and theft.

The Panther Lounge personnel had realized that some theft was going on from September on, but Gillis was only linked to this one account. For approximately two weeks the police had the Barn under surveillance. On December 16 the above charges were laid.

Gillis plead not guilty on Jan-

uary 17, 1989. His trial will be in April. At present he is under suspension. He cannot be fired as such unless he is found guilty as charged. The student Union lost roughly \$ 400 in liquor stolen. The insurance claim cannot be laid unless the defendant is found to be guilty.

Up until about four years or so ago, the Student Union had hired someone to stay in the Barn overnight as security. It was decided that rather than having only one person in just one room monitoring the whole build-

ing, an alarm system could be bought. It was and this saved much money in wages.

The security system at the Barn is actually very effective. The infra-red motion detectors monitor any movement in any room of the Barn. There are no plans to add more security. It takes two special keys to activate the alarm. The system failed in this theft because the keys were used to shut it off. Gillis was seen entering the building. There were no signs of forced entry onto the liquor coolers.

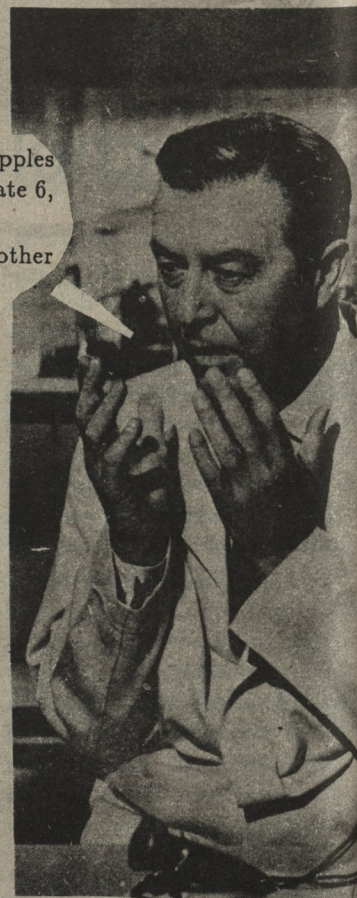
