C. M. B. A.—The Catholic Mutual Benefit Association is making substantial progress throughout Canada. There were 869 new members initiated from January 1st to August 1st in the different provinces as follows: Ontario, 590; Quebec, 86; Nova Scotia, 90; New Brunswick, 79; P. E. Island, 30; Manitoba, 29; N. W. Territories, 5. There are two Archbishops and eight Bishops of the Canadian Hierarchy members of the organization.
