### REDUCTION OF INTEREST

On Savings Bank Deposits Postponed Until Next October.

A CATCH FOR THE BIG DEPOSITORS.

Discrimination Against the Poor Ones.

[SPECIAL TO THE EXAMINER.]  
 OTTAWA, June 21.—The reduction of interest on savings bank deposits has been postponed until October next. Beside, in the event of the reduction taking place at all, the depositors are to be given the option of purchasing, up to the amount of \$1,000 each, in Dominion five year bonds bearing interest at 3 per cent. The Opposition to Hon. Mr. Fielding's proposed reduction has brought this about.

### THE SENATE VACANCY.

The St. John Sun remarks that "the government press is rather late announcing the prospective appointment of Mr. Yeo to the Senate of Canada. The appointment was settled before the election in West Prince, and was announced by the Sun at the time. Mr. Yeo had the position in his pocket when he took on himself the responsibility of the West Prince campaign. There were other men in Prince Edward Island who were at that moment, and it did not suit the government to have the appointment formally made until the election and the session were over. But Mr. Yeo has not had occasion to worry over the matter. He understood the situation."

The organ of the Vatican, Osservatore Romano, under the title "A Marvel," publishes from Turin an account of the photographing of the holy shroud recently exposed by King Humbert, who is the guardian of the relic, and authorized the photograph, which, when developed, is said to have displayed in perfect outline the holy features, hands and limbs of Christ.

Harness horses are reported to be scarce in Scotland, and that that country must come to America to have its needs supplied. The French are buying their light cab horses in America, which they formerly purchased in Germany. They claim to be able to buy their cheap horses cheaper than they can raise them. However, why should the Scotchman and the Frenchman make all their purchases in the United States? Cannot Canada supply a large share of this trade?
