SUMMARY

CURRENCIES

MONTREAL (CP) — The U.S. dollar Monday closed at a discount of 2-9/32 per cent in terms of Canadian funds, down 5-3/2. Pound sterling 2.75 3-16, down 5-16.

TORONTO

TORONTO (CP) — The stock market rallied feebly Monday near the close of trading to post a narrow gain on average but losses across the board outnumbered gains by a small majority. The base metal section started the comeback and its index had the biggest gain, up nearly one-half point. Western oils pared their loss but still closed with a dip of one-quarter of a point on their index.

The market lost ground from the opening as profit-taking reduced many of the gains recorded in last week's upsurge but towards the close the selling for profits was replaced by a small amount of buying. Quomest led senior base metals, adding 40 cents at 83. A few high-priced stocks such as International Nickel, Mining Corp. and Hudson Bay had small gains after dipping lower in morning activity. Elsewhere in the mining list, losses dominated but they were narrow. Western oils had more losses than gains but changes were generally small. Index changes: golds up .48 to 79.19; base metals up .47 to 151.61; western oils off .28 to 130.9.
