## NEW YORK

NEW YORK (AP) — Good news about the prospects of an early income tax cut sent the stock market on a rally Wednesday.

The advance came after Senate Republican leader Everett R. Dirksen said he would support President Johnson's plan that there will be a tax bill next year and that it will be retroactive to 1961.

The market had been dawdling with prices mixed until word of Dirksen's statement was received.

A buying wave developed and as prices rose to the New York Stock Exchange ticker tape twice fell behind floor transactions.

Blue chips yielded up early losses and ended with good gains.  
**CHRYSLER GAINS**

Chrysler earned an early small loss and closed with a gain of 3/4 to 8 1/4.

De Pont, down 2 1/2 at one point, recovered and advanced almost a point.

Advancing more than a point, Trans World Airlines and American Airlines reached new 1963 highs.

The Associated Press average of 30 stocks advanced 1 1/2 to 82 1/2.

The Dow Jones average of 30 industrials was up 3.69 to 755.51.  
Of 1,200 issues traded, 600 advanced and 416 declined. There were 38 new 1963 highs and 16 new lows.

Volume expanded to 4,800,000 shares from 4,540,000 Tuesday. Westinghouse Electric fell 1 1/4 at 34 on 157,000 shares was most active. Magnavox, up 2 1/4 at 67 1/2 on 106,000 shares, was second, and RCA, off 1/4 at 60 1/2 on 91,000 shares, was third.

**STEELS ADVANCE**  
Steel, mail order, retail, farm implements, aircraft, utilities, non-ferrous metals, air-frames, tobacco and drugs. 1963 models. Ray declined. Motors, rubbers and oils were mixed.

General Motors gained 1/4 to 79 1/2 and Studebaker was up 1/4 to 46 on announcement of a cost-cutting program. Ford dipped 1/4 to 31 1/2 and American Motors was off 1/4 to 19 1/2.

Among Canadian issues traded Distillers Seagrams advanced 1/2. Dominion and Hudson Bay Mining each 1/4. International Nickel 1/4 and Walker Gooderham & Pooters Preferred lost 1/4.

Prices on the American Stock Exchange were mixed. Fargo Oil gained 1/4. Brazilian Traction, Canadian National, and Seury Rainbow Oil eased. Canadian Javelin lost 1/4. Preston 1-16.

MONTREAL (CP) — The stock market forged ahead in the open, steadied at mid-day and gained toward the close Wednesday on the Montreal and Canadian exchanges.

Industrial volume hit 150,000 shares and mines and oils 245,000 shares.

The composite index added a substantial 0.10 to 125.7 and advanced pointed declines 0.71 to 71.

In industrials, 511 issues gained a nickel. De Pont's 71, Consumers' Glass, Monro Corp and Dominion Textile 1/4 each and Rockwell - Standard, Imperial Tobacco Co., Canadian Aviation Electronics and Massey-Ferguson 1/4 apiece.

International Nickel led as senior base metals higher, adding 1/2. Falconbridge rose 1/4 and Hollinger 1/4.

Dominion Foundries moved up 1/4. Algonia's, Aluminum 1/4 and Steel Co. 1/4.

In utilities, Maritime Telephone rose 1/4. Bell Telephone 1/4 and Newfoundland Light 1/4. Also rose three cents on 35, 700 shares in speculative mines.

East Ventures, drooped five cents. Dumagang and Kelly, Desmond three cents. Northern Exploration two cents.

TORONTO (CP) — A late rally raised Toronto Wednesday after a dull day of drifting prices.

The 77-stock industrial index, off 0.7 at 2 p.m., finished up 0.9 at 138.32. The 106-stock exchange index picked up near the end of trading to close at 124.88, up 0.4.

Biggest gainer on the industrial list was Simpsons, up 1 1/4 at 37 1/2. Canada Steamship Lines rose 1/4. Dominion Foundries and Steel 1/4 and B.C. Telephone and Canada Packers 1/4 each.

Lossers included Dominion Glass, off one cent at 17 1/2. Royal Bank and Walker-Gooderham 1/4 each. Imperial Bank of Commerce 1/4, and Eddy Match 1/4.

Base metals closed slightly lower. Ammonia for liquidus Geo Mines was off 1/4 but International Nickel rose 1/4 and Hudson Bay Mining 1/4.


