now returned a heart, Jais would have gone down, but East returned a spade and Jais had no trouble making five clubs. He drew two rounds of trumps and ultimately established a heart trick in dummy to take care of one of his diamond losers.

East should have defeated the contract by leading the heart return at trick two. It was not really a difficult play to make. East had all the clues he needed to work out the proper play. He could tell from the bidding that South had the K-Q of clubs and ace of hearts. Since there were only two hearts not in sight and South was known to have one of them, East should have realized that no harm could come from a heart return if South had the singleton ace, and that much good could come from a heart return if South had the doubleton ace. Playing to give West a heart ruff was clearly East's best shot.

At the second table, where an American pair held the North-South cards, the bidding went rather strangely in this fashion:

West North East South  
3♣ Pass 4♣ Dble  
Pass Pass 4♣ Pass  
Pass 5♣

Here North became declarer at five clubs after the French East had made a fancy bid of four clubs.

East led the ace of spades, on which West played the deuce, and shifted to a low heart. West ruffed and North could not avoid losing a diamond trick later. As a result, France gained 700 points on the deal.

**CP-CN pool train agreement.** The 22-year-old contract covering joint passenger services on the Montreal-Toronto, Toronto-Ottawa and Montreal-Quebec runs.

The cancellation is effective Oct. 30 and new separate services are to be inaugurated Oct. 31.

Pierre Delagrave, CNR vice-president in charge of passenger sales and services, said the CNR will operate five trains daily in each direction between Montreal and Toronto during peak periods, including two new non-stop trains which will operate on "the fastest running times ever scheduled in Canada."

The CPR plans one fast daytime train daily between the two cities.

The CNR said it will continue to operate morning, afternoon and overnight trains in each direction and will reduce running time to less than six hours.

Between Montreal and Quebec, the CNR will continue to operate its stainless steel dayliner, Le Champlain.

The CPR's existing daytime Montreal-Quebec service "will continue as at present."

## Witnesses Meet In Convention

MONTAGUE — The three-day convention of Jehovah's Witnesses currently being held in the Montague Regional High School Auditorium got underway last evening.

Delegates heard their district supervisor say, "We have been gathered together for the purpose of learning various ways and means of increasing our praise to Jehovah."

W.R. Smith, circuit minister of the Watch Tower Society for Prince Edward Island, showed how this could be done by first a family scheduling their time; second, by becoming a full-time minister if possible; and lastly, by taking advantage of some of the times we are not engaged in secular work to praise Jehovah.

Today the delegates are putting into practice some of this counsel as they call on the people in the Montague area.

The highlight of the convention comes Sunday at 3 p.m. when Mr. Wall speaks on the subject "What Does the Resurrection of the Dead Mean for You and Yours?"

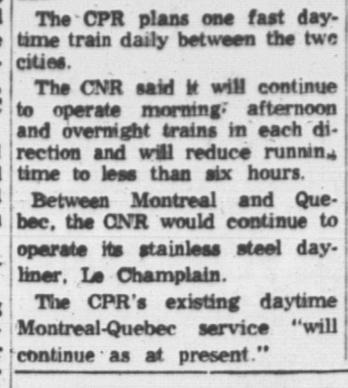
In that case, Harlow will reimburse CMHC for abandoned work.

However, if the designs and cost estimates are accepted and the work continues, CMHC will be paid fees in accordance with British architectural rates.

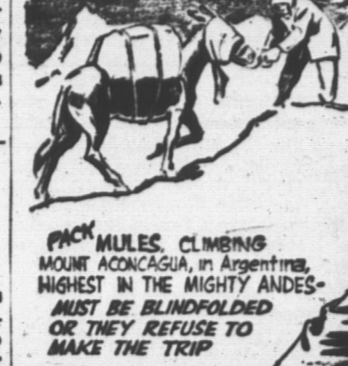
In his letter to Hamnett, Chevrier said:

"The units will be built using Canadian timber frame construction methods and timber surfaced to Canadian lumber standards. All timber and plywood used in the framing of these houses shall be of Canadian manufacture. The construction standards will be basically those used in Canada adapted to United Kingdom requirements where possible and appropriate."
