Seek Support On Algeria

PARIS (Reuters)—French Foreign Minister Christian Pineau left by plane for Rio de Janeiro Thursday to begin rallying South American support for France's Algerian policy at the fall session of the United Nations General Assembly.

During his tour Pineau will visit Argentina, Brazil, Uruguay, Chile, Peru, Ecuador and Colombia. He then is expected to meet U.S. State Secretary Dulles in Washington Sept. 7.

French Premier Maurice Bourges-Maunoury plans to call a special session of parliament toward the end of September to consider proposed political reforms for Algeria, government sources said.

Broad agreement on the principles of the new statute was reached by key ministers Wednesday. French officials said there is no desire to "impose" a new structure on Algeria, scene of a 33-month-long Moslem nationalist insurrection.

Expansion Of Credit Slows

MONTREAL (CP)—Debts owed by Canadian consumers to money-lending institutions are rising less rapidly, the Bank of Montreal says in its August business review.

This is attributed to factors including charge accounts, installment buying and personal cash loans. "Charge accounts are usually regarded as a convenience rather than a credit medium," the announcement says.

By contrast, the bank says, an estimated \$1,139,000,000—more than eight times the amount at March, 1948—was owed on installment financing at the end of last March. Of the personal cash loan factor, in the last quarter of 1956 the total in this category grew by only \$9,000,000 compared with an increase of \$51,000,000 in the same period of 1955.

Lack Of Salmon Cause Of Worry

HALIFAX (CP)—Lands Minister Levy said here Friday his department is "seriously concerned" about the lack of salmon in Nova Scotia's rivers.

He said the department has received complaints about poor salmon fishing from local anglers and tourists. Clarence Mason of Caledonia, N.S. provincial director of game conservation, will investigate the situation.

"Just as the upward leap of consumer debt contributed to the inflationary pressures in the Canadian economy in 1955 and 1956," the review says. "A slower climb in consumer debt should tend to retard the progress of inflation in 1957."

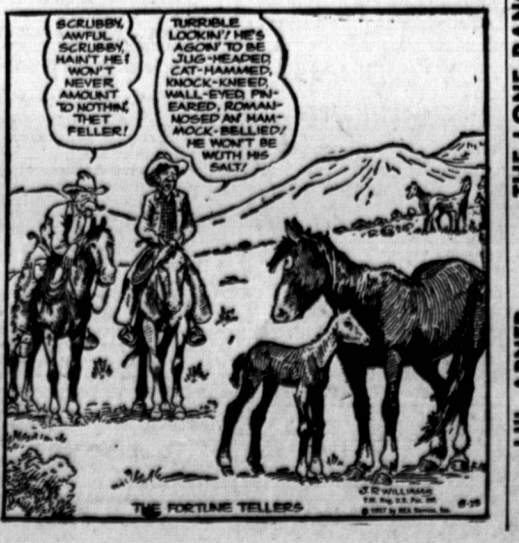
