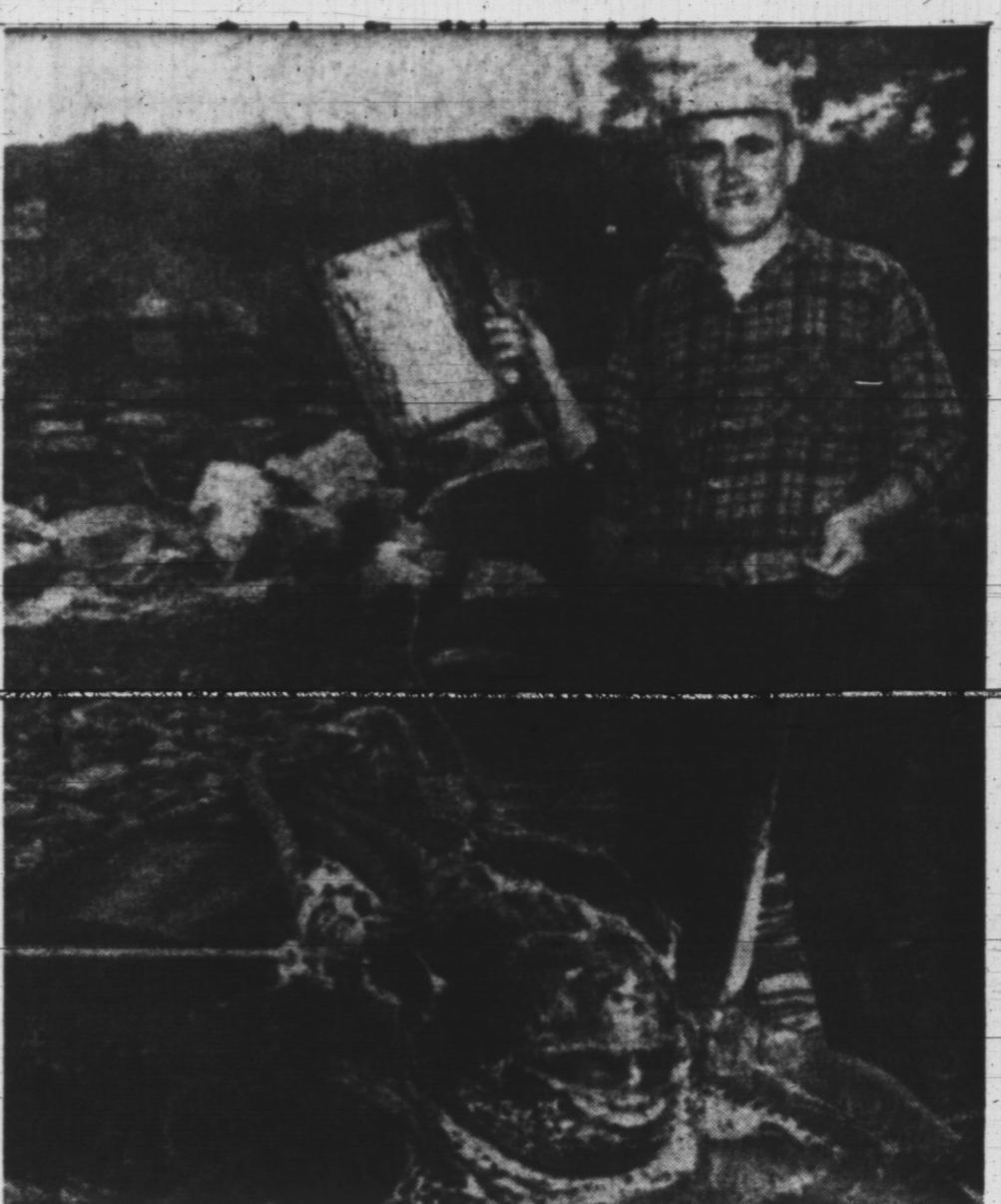

CNR Orders Hopper Cars
Canadian National Railways has ordered 700 cylindrical covered, steel hopper cars, the largest single purchase of hopper cars ever made by the railway.
The order includes the first 100-ton capacity hoppers to be introduced on the system. They are one-third larger than the standard unit, and 250 will be built in Trenton, N.S. by Hawker Siddeley's Eastern Car Plant.
The cars will have four discharge gates instead of the customary three, and will allow faster unloading. They will be used to carry coal, sand and crushed rock. Delivery has been scheduled to start in February, 1967.
The remainder of the order, for 70-ton capacity cars, will be filled by National Steel Car Corporation Ltd., Montreal, at its Hamilton, Ont., plant.
Delivery of these hoppers will begin in October. They will be used to carry such bulk commodities as potash, cement, chemicals and sugar.
The total value of the two orders is 17 million.
