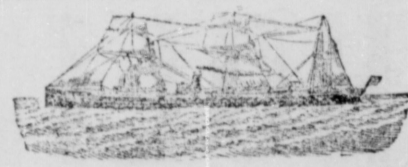


Prince Bismarck.

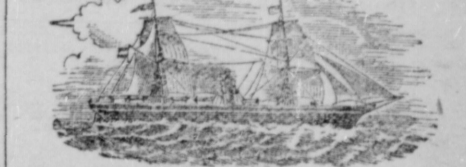
