Robot May Be Ancestor Of Weatherman Of The Future

Editor's note: It's a far cry from the day when man tried to predict the weather by wetting his finger and holding it up to see which way the wind was blowing. Forecasts are becoming more accurate every day, thanks to electronics. This first of three articles tells of some of the newest devices used in today's efforts to outguess the weather.

By FRANK CAREY WASHINGTON (AP)—In an air-conditioned room in nearby Suitland, Md., lives "701"—a robot who may be the ancestor of a legion of mechanical weather men of the future. This electronic monster—a high-speed computing machine—is being employed in research and even in some limited operational use involving a new method of weather forecasting which the U.S. weather bureau says "holds promise of becoming the most revolutionary development in meteorology in decades."

Canadian Oil Firms Accused

WASHINGTON (CP)—The securities and exchange commission Tuesday accused two Canadian oil firms of making "false and misleading" statements and ordered their capital stocks dropped from the American Stock Exchange effective April 15. A commission statement said the companies, Great Sweet Grass Oils Limited and Kroy Oils Limited, made such statements in reports concerning transactions involving the issuance of stock in exchange for oil and gas properties. It said they also made "false representations" about oil and gas reserves.
