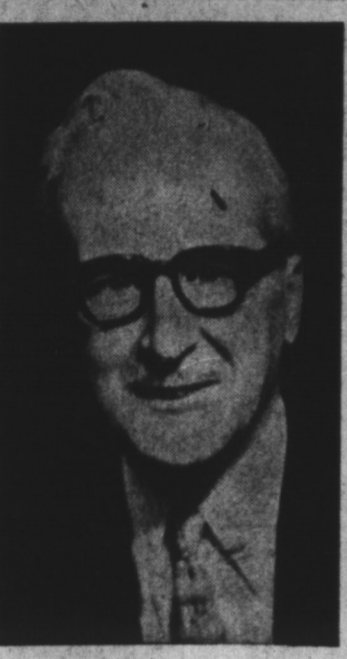
Nikita Asks Summit Date To Avoid May Day Conflict
