Discount Likelihood Of Attack On Yugoslavia

BELGRADE, Yugoslavia, July 24 — (AP) — Responsible western observers today discounted the likelihood of a Russian-led Cominform attack on Yugoslavia in the immediate future.

Official Yugoslav figures report Soviet satellites have carried out more than 800 border "provocations" since the break between the Cominform and Tito—nearly half of them this year.

May Be Months Before U. S. Counter-Offensive

WASHINGTON, July 24—(AP)—It may be mid-fall or even next spring before United States forces can launch a major counter-offensive in Korea, a high Defence Department official announced.

The official, who cannot be named, said another fall-back may occur during the days just ahead. He said it is something that has been figured on, a part of the general pattern of resisting steadily while inflicting on the enemy the heaviest losses possible.
