**ST. JOHN'S, Nfld. (CP)**—Canadian National Railways regional manager E. J. Cooke said Wednesday a fifth attempt to refloat the coastal vessel Northern Ranger, aground at Stag Rock in Bonaville Bay since Friday night. The motor vessel Nonia was due on the scene Wednesday to assist the Ranger. The steamer Codroy attempted to pull the Ranger from the rock Tuesday night but had to leave to take over the Ranger's St. John's-Corner Brook service.

Baggage and 75 passengers were removed from the stranded vessel Sunday.
