SECRET HEADQUARTERS IS FLOODED WITH CALLS

LONDON (AP)—An embarrassed British post office spokesman has explained how the secret headquarters of a new regional crime squad was flooded with calls about food, drink and lodgings. "It was all very unfortunate," said the spokesman. "We are sorry, but it was just one of those things." In Warrington Wednesday, one of Britain's new regional detective centres—designed to deal with crime at lightning speed—started business.

The second caller asked: "Can you accommodate my bride and me on our honeymoon?" The third caller inquired: "What time does your bar close?" This was too much. The commander of the new bureau telephoned the post office, which in Britain has charge of telephones. But only after several hours did the non-police calls stop. Said the post office

spokesman: "The number was one that had earlier been given to a new hotel in the area, the Paddington House. After this number had been listed in the directories, the hotel owners decided they wanted another number. "The original number then became spare and it was allotted to the crime squad. This thing should not have happened, but I'm afraid the two things were dealt with by different sections."

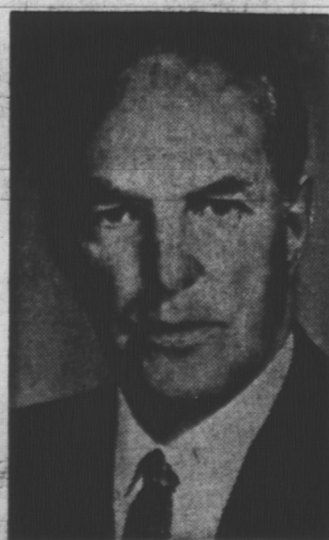

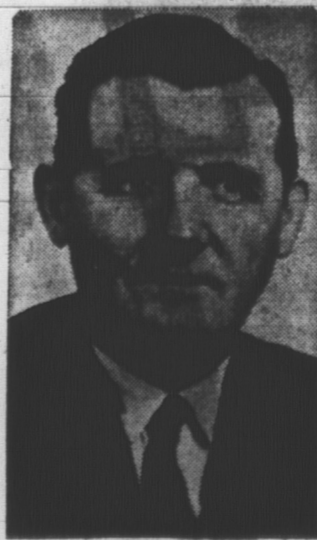
