By B. JAY BECKER. The contract is defeated. Proper play is to win the heart lead with the ace, lead a spade from dummy, and take a first round finesse. With the East-West cards being set up the way they are, declarer is done for unless the finesse is taken on your hand without the first round finesse. You'll find it impossible. Of course, it's easy enough to see the advantage of the finesse if East's cards are seen. When the finesse works, declarer enters dummy with a diamond, repeats the trump finesse, and then wraps up thirteen tricks.

### Residents Of Texas Town Plan To Flee Before Flood Waters.

DALLAS AP)—Residents of the lower Sabine River town of Deweyville Wednesday planned to abandon their community as the swollen river reached record heights upstream. "There's no use fighting this thing again," said sheriff Curtis Humphreys. The town was inundated in a 1953 flood. The misery of the 1,000 Deweyville residents was added to that of 9,000 other Texas flood victims the Red Cross estimates have fled their homes during 14 days of heavy rains and floods. Rivers east of the Sabine, which forms the Texas-Louisiana border, levelled off Wednesday and the flood threat to cities and towns eased. Croplands still were flooded, and scores of highways and feeder roads were closed. Some families still were unable to return to their homes, particularly on the upper Brazos. State disaster headquarters estimated 35,000 square miles were affected by the floods.

NEW RAINS. The weather bureau forecast new heavy rains on the Sabine watershed. Some rain fell Wednesday afternoon. John Simmons, general manager of the Sabine River authority called a meeting to lay plans in case of major flooding, particularly at Deweyville. Upriver, the Sabine was closing roads and lapping at lowland residential sections of Gladewater. Scores of oil well pumps in the Gladewater area were shut down during the night as water rose and some families left lowlands as a precautionary measure. At Longview, a short distance downstream, Carl Estes, publisher of the News-Journal, ordered a motor boat so he could reach his office from his ranch home. The Trinity River was still flooding farm acreage near Trinity, Livingston, Riverside and Liberty near its mouth. Liberty was practically encircled by high water.

Dr. Ilarton Okras, 75, Metropolitan of the Ukrainian Greek Orthodox Church of Canada, during the weekend for his religious, literary and educational work. A public reception Saturday night and a dinner-concert Sunday marked his 70th birthday and 60th anniversary of his literary career.

### MOUNTAIN RESCUE

TOKYO (Reuters)—Police Monday rescued a 24-year-old Japanese girl who had lain on a bleak mountainside for five days with a broken leg, existing on ice and orange juice. Miss Kazuko Sasaki said she fell and broke her leg April 29, a day after setting out to cross the 6,000-foot-high Tanigawadake Mountain range in Central Japan.
