AMENDMENT TO POST OFFICE ACT

Insurance by the Post-Master General.

PROVISIONS AFFECTING THE PROMOTION OF CLERKS,

And Improvements in the Forwarding of Mails, etc.

[SPECIAL TO THE EXAMINER.]

OTTAWA, June 16.—The Postmaster General has introduced a bill to amend the Post Office Act.

The most important provision is one authorizing the payment of indemnities to the extent of \$25 or lower for lost registered letters.

Provision is made for the charging of fees in this connection and for the founding of an insurance fund bill.

It also authorizes the transmission of sample newspapers on the same conditions as copies are now sent to London subscribers.

A further clause provides that any one who has spent ten years in the railway mail service whether outside or inside will be eligible for the position of superintendent of railway mail service.

There is also a clause designed to provide for the immediate despatch of mail posted after the regular closing of any particular mail.

MINE EXPLOSION IN CAPE BRETON.

Occurred at the Caledonia Mine.

ONE HUNDRED AND SIXTY BELOW AT THE TIME.

Twelve Bodies Already Recovered—A Terrible Affair.

HALIFAX, June 16.—A terrible explosion occurred in the Caledonia Mine, Cape Breton, at 2.30 this morning.

It is supposed that about 160 men were down at the time.

Twelve bodies have already been taken out.

The following bodies were recovered: Neil McDonald, Pictou, John Doyle and son, Donald Martin, Alex Macdonald and Thos Johnson, underground manager, and brother of the Assistant General Manager.
