The number of eggs laid per hen per year in the United States during the last five years, but this increase has been larger in the New England and Middle States than in any other.

It will be noticed that the average number of eggs laid per hen per year ranges from three dozen to over seven dozen and that those states which reported the largest number of eggs did not make the most money, because, as the figures show, they only get an average of four to five dozen eggs per hen per year, while the New England States showed an average of six to over seven dozen.

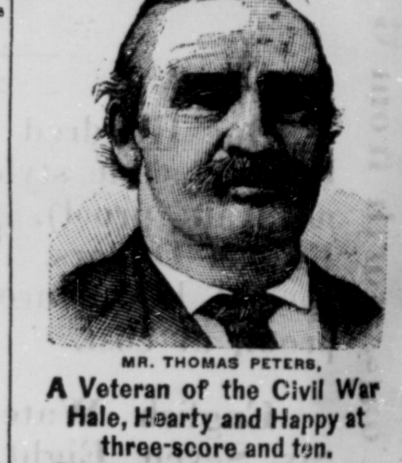
