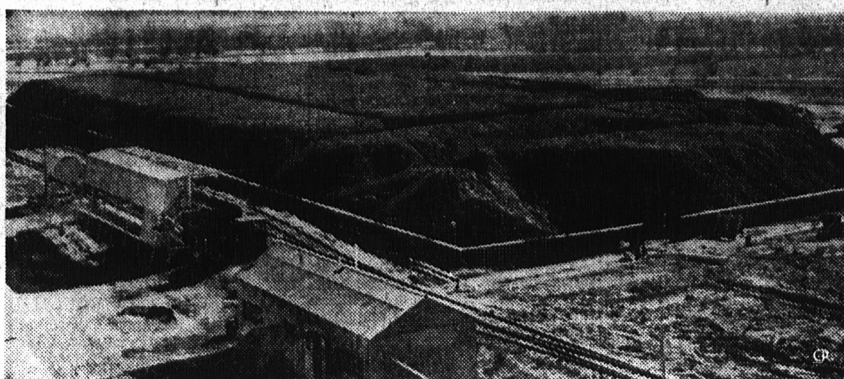

SWEET BEETS—Enough sugar to provide a year's supply for more than 250,000 persons will be extracted from this pile of sugar beets stored alongside the \$5,500,000 beet processing plant at Taber, Alta. The pile would weigh about 75,000 tons, each ton of which provides more than 300 pounds of refined sugar. A record crop of 478,000 tons, largest ever for any province, has been taken by southern Alberta's 1,592 growers from 36,778 acres of irrigated land in the Lethbridge district. N. Y. Market Advances After U. S. Election

NEW YORK, Nov. 9 — (AP) — The stock market advanced last week in an atmosphere of Republican jubilation over General Eisenhower's election. The rise encouraged heavy volume with the day after the election topping the 2,000,000-mark for the first time in more than a year. The Associated Press average of 60 stocks gained \$1.30 on the week and closed at \$107.50.

Using the AP average as a yardstick, the stock market in the last 2-1/2 weeks has regained 62 per cent of the entire reaction the market suffered in the last three months. Volume hit only four days of trading, volume hit a total of 5,632,000 shares—a daily average of 1,658,000 shares. The stock market on the electioneering Monday made a moderate advance with heavy volume.

Over-election-day orders poured into brokers houses, and when the gong sounded the opening of business Wednesday there was a buying rush that snowed under the ticker reporting system for a brief time. Prices zoomed up in the first half hour, then worked lower under persistent profit-taking. Profit-taking was absorbed, but unusual weakness in the railroads gave the market a mixed look at the close.

Gives Report On Polio Foundation

TORONTO, Nov. 9 — (CP)—Arm and Racine, public trustee for Ontario, said Wednesday that in a little more than two years the Ontario branch of the Canadian Foundation for Poliomyelitis collected more than \$379,000 but had only \$162,947 available for medical services.

Mr. Racine made public his report on an investigation into the fund's Ontario operations. The inquiry was ordered in April, 1951, by Judge T. H. Barton of Toronto. The report showed that between Feb. 3, 1949, and March 31, 1951, Horace Brown, executive director, received \$16,509 in salary, \$4,160 in severance allowance and \$6,603 in travelling expenses.

Early in 1951, Mr. Racine reported that there appeared to be public criticism of the foundation. In January staff was curtailed and economies effected. "Dr. W. T. Mustard (a member of the board) had already taken steps in April 1951, to have this investigation by me made under the recent amendments to the Charities Accounting Act," Mr. Racine said. A month earlier the executive committee decided on a complete reorganization.

Mr. Racine said that when the foundation's re-organization was carried out the first financial statement "indicates that the budgetary requirements for organization, campaign and administrative costs have been radically reduced and they would appear to have strictly
