SCOLDING WOMEN.

Formerly the "common scold"—the woman who made her neighbors' lives intolerable with her raging temper, her bitter tongue, her slanders and calumnies—was fast disappearing. They were passed recognizing her as one kind of criminal. There were two forms of punishment by which she was repressed or deterred, or cowed into gentleness; viz, the cuckooing-stool and the brank. The cuckooing-stool consisted of a chair on one end of which, which rested on a bar so as to make a see-saw. Sometimes the chair was hung from the beam by a chain. The culprit being tied on the chair, the other end of the beam went up and the chair went down into the water, soiling the woman completely. They did this three times, after which they let her go.

Such stools belonged to nearly every parish; like the stocks and the pillory, they formed part of the furniture of justice. For instance, about London, there was one on Bankside, with which they ducked the wives of the players. There was one at Ratcliff; one at Kingston-on-Thames, and there was one which stood till the beginning of this century beside the great pond or reservoir of the Green Park.


