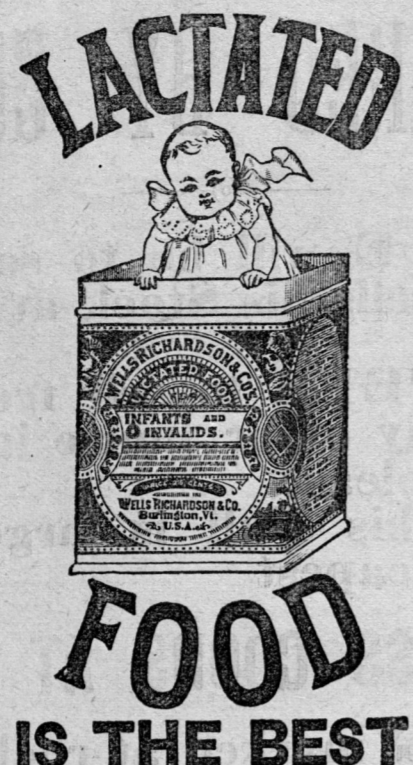


Summer Arrangements for Travel.

Trains leave Charlottetown for the West at 6 a. m., 8.45 a. m., and 3.30 p. m. (standard time) daily. Trains leave Charlottetown for Georgetown and Souris at 6.30 a. m. and 3.15 p. m. (standard time) daily. Trains leave Tignish for the East at 6 a. m. and 1.10 p. m. (standard time) daily. Trains leave Georgetown for the West at 7 a. m. and 2.40 p. m. (standard time) daily. Trains leave Souris for the West at 6.15 a. m. and 1.20 p. m. (standard time) daily. One of the P. E.
