## IN MEMORIAM

**JAMES F. MACDONALD**  
After an illness of only two days, the death occurred in the City Hospital on August 12th of James F. MacDonald. His wife was at his bedside with several of his children.

He was 73 years of age and a life-long resident of Bristol where he was born, a son of Roderick and Ellen (Coffin), MacDonald.
