Congress Of Commonwealth Mining Will Cross Canada

Some 500 mining experts from about 75 countries will take a country-wide look at the Canadian mining industry this year.

The congress will convene in Vancouver Sept. 8 and, after meetings there, will leave Sept. 11 sessions end in Halifax Oct. 9. Other major meetings will be held in Edmonton, Winnipeg, Toronto, Ottawa, Montreal and Quebec.

The main cross-country tour will be by train, with supplementary aerial trips to more northern points.

Eskimo Museum Shows Carvings

CHURCHILL, Man. (CP) - Carvings by Eskimos, depicting their life in the north, are displayed in the Eskimo Museum, one-storey wooden building in this Hudson Bay town.

The collection has grown steadily since 1942 when it was opened by the Oblate Fathers as a part of the Churchill Roman Catholic Mission.

The priest now in charge is Rev. Rene Belair, a veteran of 14 years in the Arctic. He spent eight years at Baffin Island before being transferred to Churchill in 1950.

The carvings were made out of stone found in the area. They show scenes of Eskimos hunting and fishing.

A series of paintings by artists of northern life also hangs in the museum as well as photographs of important events in the district.

Commonwealth Troops In Korea Feel Forgotten Men

SEOUL, South Korea (Reuters) - South Korea are beginning to feel they are forgotten men. They say the people back home seem to be unaware of the part they are playing in deterring further Communist aggression in Korea.

The first of its kind, the composite division lasted four years and eight months. It contained a Canadian infantry brigade, the 29th United Kingdom Infantry Brigade and Australian and New Zealand forces with the 28th Brigade.

The South Korean Army and one United States division hold the entire front facing the Communists.

Living conditions are still hard and facilities primitive. But they now represent a degree of comfort compared with those of the war years. Tents have given way to quarters and other semi-permanent wooden buildings.

More than \$3,800,000 in 6 1/2 years of active operation, the Atkinson Charitable Foundation has awarded \$3,832,076 to 347 charitable projects within Ontario.
