

Visiting the Sick.

As visiting the sick is one of the important duties of our lives, it might be well for us to study how in performing this duty we may do the most good. In visiting the sick it is best to go in the forenoon; they are then rested, and your call will benefit them more than in the afternoon. Many take the latter time for going, often to the injury of the sick one. Such calls are frequently followed by a nervous, sleepless night. Where assistance is needed it is well to go soon after breakfast, especially if it is where you are acquainted, and even if it is not, for if help is really needed one should not stand upon etiquette. Take along your "big apron" so as to be ready for whatever may be wanted of you. Do not go to the front door and knock, or what is still worse, ring the bell. Surely no one who has ever had the care of the sick, has witnessed the shock that this gives the poor sufferers (perhaps awakening from a much needed sleep), would ever be guilty of doing so. In the sick-room help is most generally acceptable in the morning. Enter with a cheerful face, and let the conversation also be cheerful. Do not speak of accidents, sickness or death, that may have occurred in the neighborhood. Another thing that should never be done is to look directly into the face of the sick one. It is embarrassing, even to a person in health, to be thus stared at, much more to one who has borne weeks, and perhaps months, of suffering. We are glad to believe that there are few who do so, but that there are some, is sufficient cause for speaking against it. When your visit is ended, come away quietly, and perhaps without saying "good-bye" to the sick one. Who is there that has not seen people (kind-hearted people, too), say good-bye, and then stand and talk awhile, and then say good-bye again, and even to the third time.

The London Lancet has a strong touch of the penny dreadful about its articles. It is always discovering something that is going to decimate the human race with startling rapidity. It has found death in the food we eat and the water we drink. It has revealed instruments of destruction in the sewing machine and the bicycle, and now it has got a new life destroyer—"There is no more powerful apparatus for the conveyance of disease than a book," says the Lancet. "Measles, scarlet fever, diphtheria, sore throat, whooping-cough, bronchitis, and perhaps phthisis can be communicated by a harmless-looking book." The germs of disease "may lie for weeks, months, or perhaps years between the pages of a bound book, to be dislodged at some unpropitious moments when the volume chances to be handled by a susceptible person." This theory ought to be immensely popular with school boys and opponents of free libraries, but the worst of the discovery is that no remedy can apparently be provided for the difficulty unless we give up civilization and relapse into a condition of life where our pleasure will be to "catch the wild goat by the hair and hurl our fancies in the sun."—Toronto Mail.
