2.5 Million Bond Issue Sold By Government

 Provincial Treasurer M. Alban announced yesterday a \$2,500,000 bond issue has been sold by the government.

The sale of the Province of Prince Edward Island five-and-one-half per cent, 20-year non-callable debentures, dated March 1, 1964, was made to a syndicate composed of Green Shield Insurance, Equitable Securities Canada Limited, and the Toronto-Dominion Bank at a price of \$88.30 per \$100.

"Cost to the province is 5.78 per cent."

The favourable reception to the sale of the bonds will be used for payment of temporary loans incurred for capital expenditures.

"This sale," he said, "was the result of offers made voluntarily by three large syndicates following the sale of \$20,000,000 Nova Scotia bonds."

Mr. Farmer said "this issue, with an issue of the same amount of five and a quarter per cent, 20-year bonds sold last November, completes the borrowing of new money for the current fiscal year."

"There will be an issue, however, of \$2,500,000 made sometime in March, to refund the balance remaining after applying sinking fund cash accumulations to an original issue of \$2,500,000 four per cent debentures which expires on Feb. 15, 1964."
