

Girl Wins Case Over Radar Trap

OTTAWA (CP)—A teen-aged Ottawa girl and her father convinced a magistrate here that radar traps can be wrong. A charge of going 45 miles an hour in a 30-mile zone against Susan Joan Edser, 18, was dismissed by Magistrate Livius Sherwood after she decided to fight the charge because "evidence was such that I saw fit to dismiss."

Susan's father told the court he was sure the small, four-year-old car she was driving was "mechanically unable to accelerate" to 45 miles an hour in the distance involved.

Magistrate Sherwood, after he dismissed the case, said that "this in no way reflects upon the reliability of the radar set."

"Every case is judged on its own merits. You have to remember that a radar set is still run by a human being."

PC Probe Of Election Is Completed

OTTAWA (CP)—Lawyers for the Progressive Conservative party have completed their investigation of alleged election irregularities in Des-à-la-Madeleine.

A party spokesman said here that no decision on further action will be taken until party leader Diefenbaker returns from a Caribbean holiday Dec. 21.

Charges of irregularities arose when Judge Joseph Durossy of Grindstone, Que., said he was telephoned by Forestry Minister Sauve on election day last Nov. 8 and that Mr. Sauve protested the release of two men from jail to vote. The two men had earlier been charged with threatening a Liberal.

The judge has said he received "at least two, possibly three" calls from Mr. Sauve, Liberal candidate in the riding, an island in the Gulf of St. Lawrence.

The party spokesman said that the preparations are being made as though further action will be taken, but he said this will rest with Mr. Diefenbaker.

He said there are several courses open under the Canada Elections Act and that it is possible the matter will be raised in the Commons.

Meanwhile, Mr. Sauve has scheduled a press conference here for today when he is expected to deal with the allegations. He returned from Rome Sunday and said he was investigating the charges that had been made.

BREATH CASE IS DISMISSED

MILTON, Ont. (CP) — A man who was given a breath analysis test while unconscious in hospital was acquitted here on a charge of drunken driving after the result of the test was admitted as evidence.

Magistrate Kenneth Langdon said it was with great reluctance that he dismissed the charge against Dieter Shack, 40, of Port Credit. Milton is 30 miles west of Toronto.

Constable Leonard George testified he gave the test in the intensive care ward of an Oakville hospital three hours after a car Shack had been driving went off Highway 122.

He said the reading of 1.7 showed the accused drank the equivalent of seven bottles of beer or 10.5 ounces of liquor. The magistrate admitted the evidence despite defence objections that an accused may only be subjected to such tests of his own free will.

In dismissing the charge the magistrate said the blood level might possibly have been lower three hours earlier, when the car went off the road.

AFL-CIO Asks Outside Aid Against Cuba

SAN FRANCISCO (AP)—The AFL-CIO has called on Canada, Britain, Japan and Spain to join the United States boycott on trading with Cuba and help end "military dictatorships in this hemisphere."

In a resolution on Latin America, adopted unanimously at the convention of the big United States labor federation said:

"We insist on strengthening the economic boycott against Communist Cuba and demand that the United Kingdom, Canada, Japan and Spain cease their commercial dealings with Castro."

The resolution also called on the U.S. and the Organization of American States to enforce "guarantees to organized labor" in Latin America.

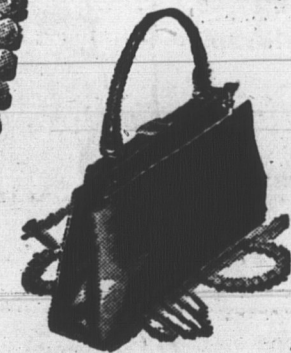

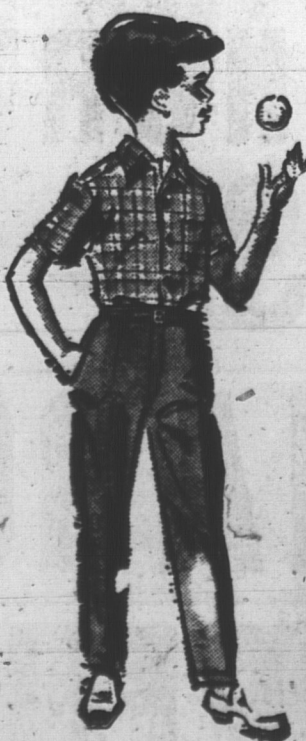

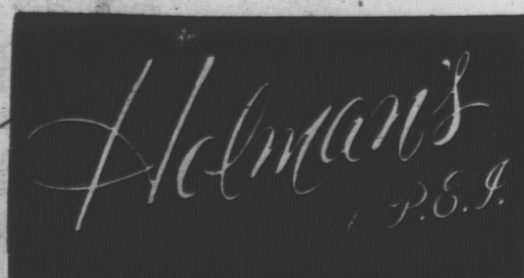
