Notice to Commercial Travellers.
 The attention of Commercial Travellers is called to the fact that the Province of Prince Edward Island, by an Act of the Legislature, has passed an Act to impose a Direct Tax on Certain Classes of Travellers.

From and after the passing of this Act every casual trader not permanently residing in this Province, and who sells either for himself or any other person any goods, wares or merchandise in this Province, or solicits or canvasses for orders either for himself or any other person, or procures the production or purchase of any goods, wares or merchandise, or procures the printing or writing of any catalogue, printed or written matter, or simply by word of mouth without the production of samples, photographs, catalogues, printed or written matter, shall, before he is allowed upon the business of so selling any goods, wares or merchandise, or soliciting or canvassing for such orders, pay to the Provincial Treasurer of the Province a special license fee of direct tax of fifteen dollars.

This Act is now in force. License can be procured in Charlottetown at the Provincial Treasury, in Summersdale from Wm. T. Hunt Esq., in Georgetown from George B. Atkinson Esq.
