Powerful Icebreaker Sets New Records On Supply Job

OTTAWA (CP)—The powerful Canadian icebreaker John A. Macdonald has established three records this year during the transport department's 1962 Arctic supply operation.
The ship sailed further north than any other vessel in the waters of the Canadian archipelago, made the first passage through sections of Norwegian Barents Sea which had become the only ship to circumnavigate the Prince of Wales Island.

The agreement became effective after Treasury Secretary Dillon said the United States has appropriated \$2,000,000,000 as its share of the emergency pool to be supplied by 10 leading Western nations.
