Butter Output Down, Margarine Climbs Steadily

OTTAWA, June 11 - (CP) - While Canadian production of creamery butter is dropping, the output of margarine is steadily climbing. The Bureau of Statistics reported today that production of creamery butter in May dropped from 31,987,000 pounds a year ago to 28,618,000. The total five-month output for 1950 was estimated at 78,791,000, a drop of more than 3,000,000 pounds from last year's January-May production of 81,865,000. Production of the butter substitute during May increased to 8,019,000 pounds from 7,190,000 last year, the Bureau said. In the first five-month period of 1950, margarine output climbed to 42,922,000 pounds from 26,259,000 in the same period a year ago. A comparison of stocks on hand on June 1 showed that holdings of butter are increasing, while margarine stocks are going down. On June 1, stocks of creamery butter held by the Government and private trade totalled 31,945,000 pounds, compared with 28,440,000 on May 1 and 24,203,000 pounds on June 1, 1949. Margarine stocks totalled 3,091,000 pounds, a decline from the May 1 total of 4,022,000 pounds. There was no estimate of holdings on June 1 last year.

It informed all shipping companies and airlines that beginning June 15 all Chinese must have an entry permit from the Hong Kong Immigration Department.
