The score stood 3-2 for the Wings until the five minute mark when Detroit's Warren Godfrey fell trying to clear the puck from behind his own cage.

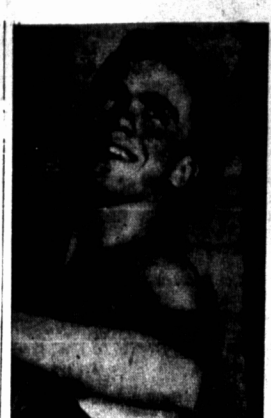
