## DR. AYERS

### Prohibition in West Africa.

LONDON, May 15.—Mr. Chamberlain received a deputation from the United Committee for the Prevention of the Demoralization of Native Races by the Liquor Traffic with reference to the meeting of the powers at Brussels. Sir Mark Stewart, who introduced the deputation, complained that in West Africa prohibition of the sale of spirits was hardly known. Mr. Chamberlain, in reply, spoke strongly against the traffic. The evil in the British territory was not on the increase, although in the last year or two it has not sufficiently decreased, and gave figures in proof of the statement. While he hoped for great things from the Brussels conference, he would not in any case be content to remain where we are. There was a large inland territory when hitherto spirituous liquors have not been accepted, and where he thought they could take steps to prevent entirely their introduction.

Said Mr. Chamberlain: "The governor of the Gold Coast is at home; I am expecting Colonel Northcott, in command of the northern territories here very shortly; and I propose, in consultation with these two gentlemen, to endeavour to arrange for a prohibitive zone in the northern territories of the Gold Coast. Already Colonel Wilcox, in command of the Niger, has issued a proclamation of absolute prohibition in the territories under his control. That applies to the Hinterland of the Niger, and of course where the Niger territories come under my control I do not intend to relax in any way the restrictions which Sir George Goldie has so well taken. I think it will be tolerably easy to prevent any traffic by railways beyond the border line. Of course the measures which I have taken will be accompanied by legislation in these colonies. For we must have very stringent legislation, punishing those who contravert the regulations which will be necessary to enforce.

### Niger-Nile Negotiations.

PARIS, May 12.—The Chamber of Deputies yesterday approved the Anglo-French Niger-Nile convention. This agreement between Great Britain and France settles the boundaries of thousands of square miles of African territory and only leave four recognized independent states—Morocco, Abyssinia, Liberia, and the Orange Free State. An important feature of the agreement provides for an equality in the commercial treatment of the territory between Lake Toba and the Nile.

A correspondent of the London Daily News, in reporting the opening of the new county councils in Ireland says: "Striking as are the changes accomplished by the new Act, still more striking is the spirit of quiet, orderly, self-respecting reserve with which it has been carried into effect. For close on a decade the Nationalists of Ireland have been rent in twain by a painful internecine conflict. In the proceedings of the first Council meetings there was not even the faintest suggestion of unhealthy conflict. Differences there were, as there always must be, amongst intelligent men, but not a single ugly incident occurred to mar the harmony of the various meetings. That the people should have so suddenly risen to the demands of a new situation, requiring tact, discretion, and judgement, especially under the present circumstances in Ireland, conveys in itself a moral that needs no laboured argument. "Faction and feud are passing away," sang a poet of the Young Ireland period. It would seem as if his dream had been accomplished.

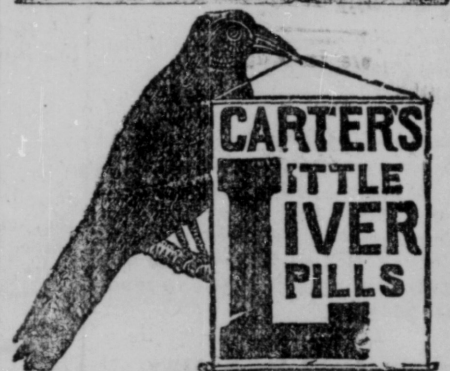
