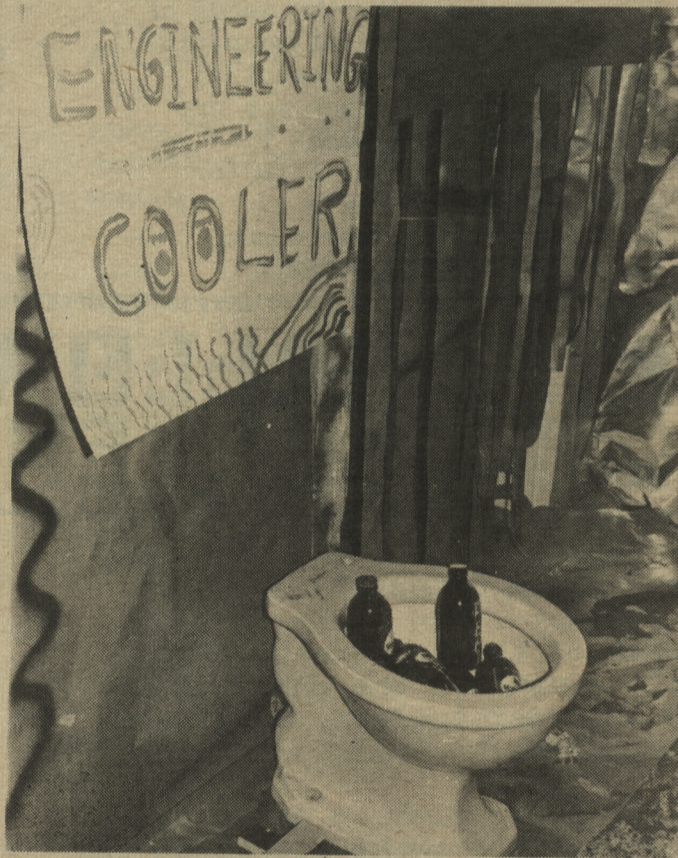


# OPEN HOUSE
