

Cause of Summer Complaints.

The direct cause of pain and looseness of the bowels is an irritation of the mucous membrane of the same, sufficient to produce excessive peristaltic or worm-like motion in the interior of the bowels by which means the matter in the bowels is naturally carried through them. Indirect causes of diarrhoea, by which an irritation is started are intestinal dyspepsia, overeating, uric acid or overripe fruit, tanned meats, or oysters, &c.; torpor of liver, by which not bile is secreted; excessive flow of bile, etc. TREATMENT. 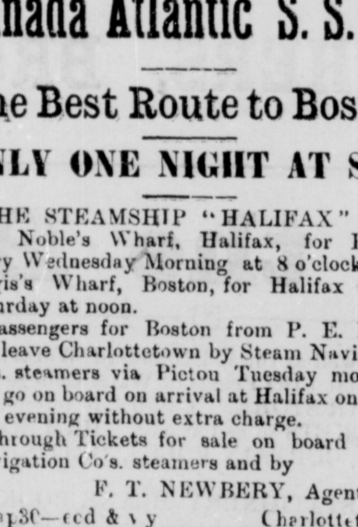

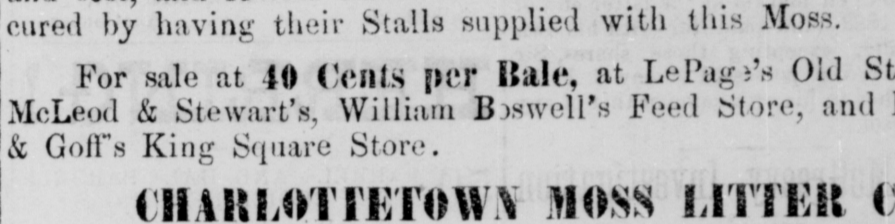

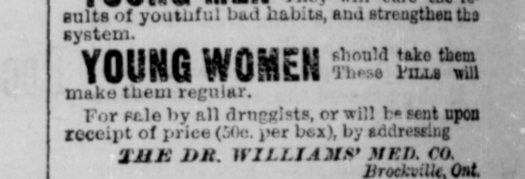
