County Magistrate Imposes \$50 Fines

SUMMERSIDE—Two persons appeared before Magistrate W. Chester S. MacDonald in Prince County court yesterday on separate charges of driving while their license was suspended and both pleaded guilty to the charge.

Gerald Joseph McCarville, Freetown and Joseph Edward Hache, Richmond, were each fined \$50 and costs on the charge.

Joseph Alphonse Richards, Bonville, pleaded guilty to a charge of failing to report an accident to the RCMP where the damage was more than \$50 and was assessed a fine of \$50 and costs.

A Northam man, Gordon Grigg, was fined \$20 and costs for failing to stop for a stationery school bus.

Earle Johnson, Collicutt, Searletown, was fined \$10 and costs for driving without a license and on a second charge of driving a vehicle not properly equipped with braking equipment, was fined \$20 and costs.

For failing to stop at a stop sign, Ken Ball, St. John's, was fined \$10 and costs. Hubert Howard MacNeill, Central Bedouque, pleaded not guilty to a similar charge and his case was adjourned to July 26th.

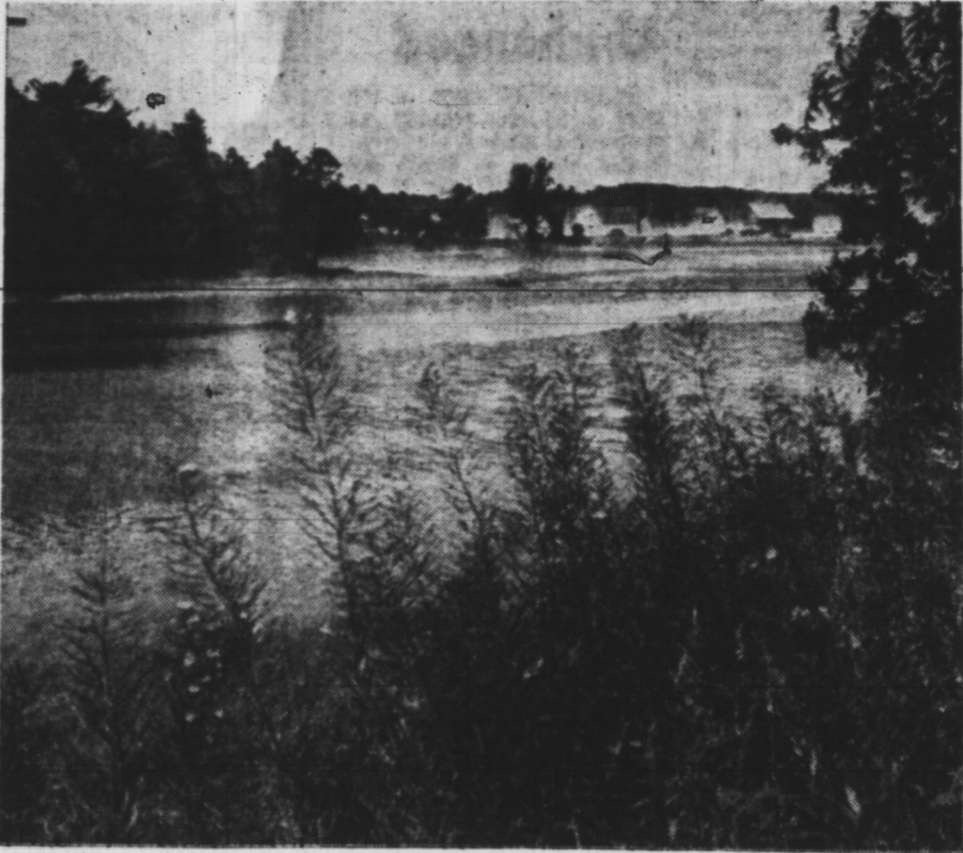
PRESENTS CERTIFICATE

Lifeguard Tests Are Set For Today

At ten o'clock this morning eleven National Park lifeguards will meet at Stanhope main beach for the "Surf" qualification test. This is the final stage of a two week Red Cross sponsored training and conditioning course held at the YMCA June 7-19 under the direction of guards David Large and Herb Murphy.

Four hours daily were spent in the pool in a general conditioning swim, and specific training for the Royal Life Saving Society Award of Merit and National Lifeguard test.

In the lecture room, the guards were taught the latest techniques of beach surveillance, choosing a swimming area, first aid and the use of resuscitators. Each lifeguard post at the National Park is equipped with a resuscitator and first aid kit.

SPEAKERS

Special speakers on the course were Mrs. Evelyn Cutmore, director of first aid and water safety, on the history of lifeguard training on P.E.I.; Don MacAulay, superintendent of the National Parks, on conditions of employment; Dr. Ross Stewart on resuscitation of the apparently drowned; Sinclair Outcliffe, on first aid emergencies, and Wendell Proffitt, director of Provincial Parks.

The surf qualification test at Stanhope, held preferably under rough water conditions is basically a test of endurance and skill in the use of lifeguard equipment. Each guard is required to approach a pseudo-victim at a distance of 400 yards with each of boat, paddle board, and torpedo buoy; contact the victim and return the 400 yards to shore with the victim in tow.

NATIONAL LEVEL

Totaled, this comes to 3400 yards, excluding the added distance that comes as being a victim for the other guards. This test, although recognized at the national level is held only on P.E.I. The P.E.I. National Park Lifeguards are unique in being

the only qualified surf trained lifeguards in Canada.
