NATO HEARS REPORT

US Bombers on Strike Swifly in Case of Need

PARIS (AP)—The boss of the U.S. Strategic Air Command warned the Soviet Union Tuesday his bombers around the world are loaded with nuclear weapons and ready to strike swifly in case of attack.

Gen. Thomas Power told a press conference the SAC mounted an alert Oct. 1, that there always are some of the great bombers in the air and they are "not carrying orders or bombs and arrows."

The general struck at the recent claim of Communist chief Nikita Khrushchev that the intercontinental Ballistic Missile (ICBM) had made warplanes obsolete.
