

Rhodesia Imposes Penalties On Coal, Coke For Zambia

SALISBURY (Reuters)—Rhodesia has imposed new duties on coal and coke going to neighboring Zambia which depends on the supplies to keep its main industry, the wealthy copper mines, running.

The new move came Sunday night, 24 hours after Prime Minister Ian Smith's white-minority regime temporarily suspended oil products to Zambia.

Smith said the new measure is aimed at helping his government maintain the economy in the face of what he called the latest British attack on Rhodesia—the oil embargo imposed Friday.

"The oil embargo and other embargoes are aimed at forcing Smith's regime to end its break with Britain. The rebels seized independence for Rhodesia after Britain refused to grant it without guarantees for eventual Negro-majority rule."

In a speech on radio and television—his second in two days—Smith said the royalty on all coal exported to Zambia would be £5 (\$15) a short ton and on all coke exports there would be a compensating export tax of £8 (\$24) a short ton.

(Amount of the old duties was not immediately known.)

In his speech Smith said:

"It is to be regretted that we have had to resort to these measures; it is to be regretted even more that the greatest hardship will be borne by—not the real culprits, the British government—but by the people of Zambia.

COUNTRY DEFIANT

"However, if it has not been appreciated up to the present I hope it will be now that the more we are attacked the more determined, indeed the more defiant, we become."

Smith said he hopes the revenue from the coal royalty would meet Rhodesia's present requirements, but if it does not then the central African colony would have to consider a further increase.

"We will never, no matter what the cost, allow the forces of evil to break down our type

of civilization which has taken almost 2,000 years to create," Smith said.

"I suppose there is even a possibility that reason and justice may return to the scene and that the cantankerous old lioness (Britain) will acknowledge that what was once a lusty young cub has now grown to full manhood, and that the best policy for all is to allow him to go quietly on his way living his own life, minding his own business, and contributing nothing but good to the common welfare."

Meanwhile, growing uncertainty among white Rhodesians

about the future consequences of last month's seizure of independence from Britain has lent an almost frenzied touch to Christmas celebrations here.

GAIETY ON SURFACE
The apparent sense of gaiety, however, has been unable to mask the feeling of insecurity among many whites.

Most of Rhodesia's 230,000 whites—there are 4,000,000 Negroes—seem to believe this Christmas has to be enjoyed because it is impossible to foresee what the next Christmas will hold for them.

Freighter Sinks For Second Time

BREST, France (Reuters)—The East German freighter Magdeburg, which capsized in the Thames River at London last year with a cargo of British

Saturday night, the 6,629-ton ship lay under 50 fathoms of water on the Atlantic seabed a few miles off the French coast. Maritime officials said it would be almost impossible to salvage her this time.

The East German tug Albatros was towing the freighter—without anybody aboard—from London to Piraeus, Greece.

The tug crew, who put into Brest Saturday, said they ran into storms in the Bay of Biscay. The Magdeburg capsized and sank but the tugmen were able to cast off the tow line and had not been in danger.
