TORONTO (CP)—A Briefing flurry fluffed to clear the stock market of profit-taking Tuesday and it closed in a quietly mixed tone. Trading was moderately heavy.

The base metal and western oil indices closed with only minor changes from Monday's close. Price changes remained mostly within fractional ranges but a few pivotal stocks had gains or losses of two points.

Senior base metals recorded fractional price changes with Consolidated Smelters, Hudson Bay and International Nickel on the winning side and Noranda among the losers. Nickel Rim gained 25 cents among juniors and Mogul 20 cents. Cassiar lost 20 cents and Little Long Lac 15 cents.

Coppers were stronger with Campbell Chibougamau up 1/2; Chibougamau-Jacquet 55 cents; Chibougamau 25 cents and Coldstream 20 cents.

Vico drew more-than-average interest in western oils, losing 45 cents. Central Leduc was off 25 cents. Canadian Devonian 20 cents and Canadian Export Gas 15 cents. Commonwealth was ahead 30 cents and Del Rio 15 cents.

N. Y. STOCKS

NEW YORK (AP)—The stock market pushed higher in quiet trading Tuesday although there was a liberal share of small losers. Volume picked up toward the close and a renewed advance raised oils, aircrafts and coppers narrowly.

The advance failed to recover all the ground lost in a mild decline Monday. Gulf Oil, which lost 4% in the previous session, was again heavily traded and picked up 2 points to close at 129 1/2. Royal Dutch more than made up its small loss of Monday with a gain of 2%.

In the last several weeks the market has fluctuated just under its all-time high of last April when the Associated Press average hit \$191.50. The average of 60 stocks rose 90 cents Tuesday to \$189.10. Boeing was the most active issue of the day, with 28,700 shares traded. It advanced 2 1/2 to 53 1/2. Among steels, Bethlehem gained 1 1/2. Youngstown lost 1/2 and Republic was unchanged.

Aluminum Ltd. with a gain of 1, led Canadian issues on the New York stock exchange. Walker Gooderham and Hudson Bay Mining each gained 1/2, followed by International Nickel, up 1/2. McIntyre and Dome Mines both were off 1/4 on the day's trading.

Expect Big Profits From New Panama Stamps Issue

PANAMA CITY (Reuters) — A stamp issue from which American promoters hope to make about \$40,000,000 profit has gone on sale here. Each of the 12 values in the issue bears the likeness of one of the Popes Pius, ranging from Pope Pius I on the two-cent green to the present Pope Pius XII on the \$2 purple.

This incursion of private enterprise into the stamp-issuing business has been under negotiation here for several years. The promoters, whose names have not been officially revealed, have had the stamps printed at their own expense in California. They presented the stamps to the Panamanian postal system on the basis of the Panama government retaining 60 per cent of the revenue and the promoters 40 per cent.

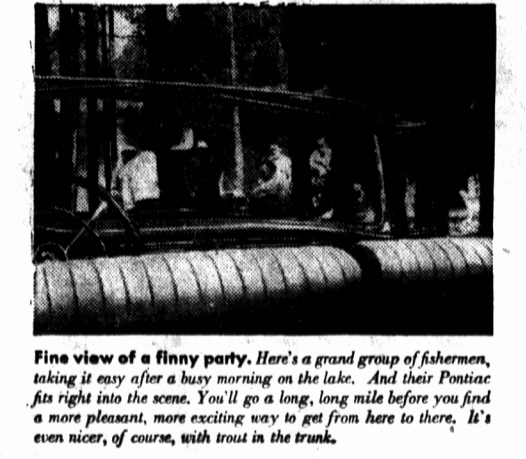
But the promoters hope that the combination of faith and philately will bring a worldwide demand for the pictures of the popes.

Although the issue is to be on sale for only six months, the printing is authorized to include 30,000,000 of the \$2 Pope Pius XII stamp. This is probably as many \$2 stamps as Panama's postal services would normally need in 25 years.

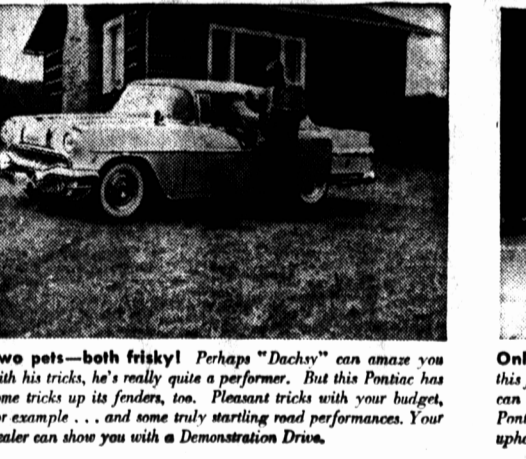

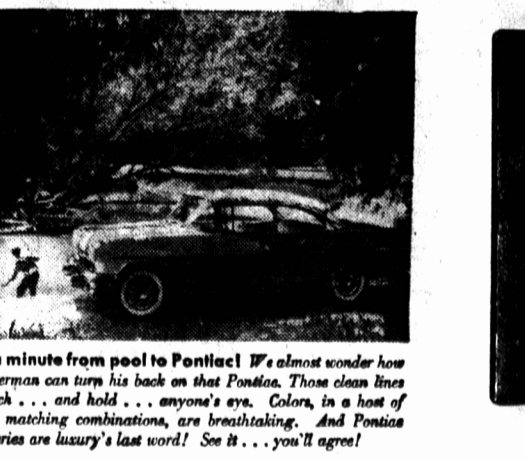

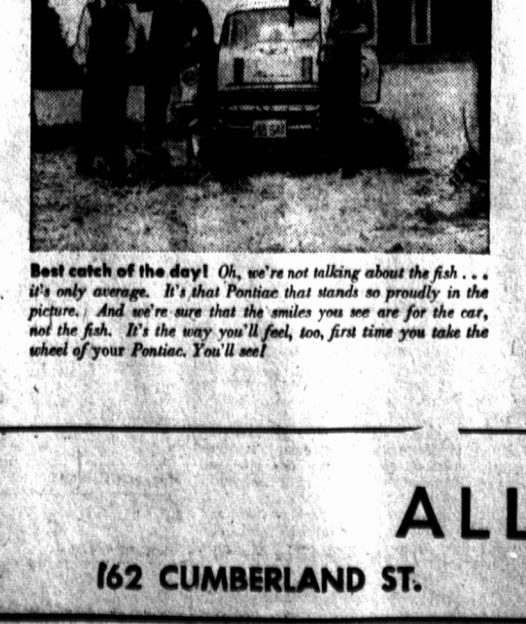
