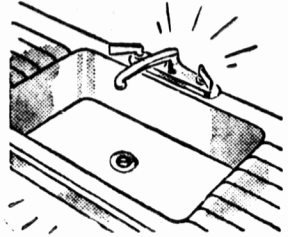

and to sleep the same as other workmen. Naturally I learned in time that this working outdoors or indoors was really occupational therapy by which the patients not only kept in better physical condition but improved mentally because when working, they were not thinking inwardly of themselves and their morale was raised because they were doing useful work like those who were not patients. In those days there was no such work as psychiatry, which has to do with the behavior of a patient. The word neurology was in use because neurology is the science of the structure of the brain and a disturbance of this structure was considered the cause of mental symptoms.

In the Ontario Medical Review, Dr. R. B. Palmer states, "A generation ago most mental disturbance was thought to be hereditary and medical treatment was considered of little value. Psychiatry was regarded as an art and was not accepted as a science even as recently as ten years ago."

Today, psychiatry has proved itself to be a true science, perhaps even one of the basic sciences of medicine.

Even if psychiatry is now considered a basic science, such as physiology or anatomy, Dr. Palmer points out that art, how to approach and gain the patient's confidence, is a big factor in the successful treatment of mental cases. It is now recognized that much mental trouble is acquired (not inherited) and that these illnesses require the attention of the doctor as much as any other disease. The physician of yesterday with his "bedside manner" has been ridiculed for not practicing "scientific" medicine. "Is there much difference between some of his work and that of the present-day psychiatrist with his couch as he practices psychotherapy?"

In practicing the art of medicine, much time must be spent with the patient. Part of that time today is now spent as a science in the laboratory, the X-ray department, the library and the operating room. As a result more time is spent studying illness and more is being done for the patient."

Dr. Palmer further states that while it is not desired to replace all of the art of healing by science, neither should science be sacrificed to art. The thought, then is that as most mental illness arises from emotional disturbances, this fact must be kept always in mind by the regular, practicing or family physician.

Judge Says Parents' Over Protection May Cause Trouble

TIMMINS, (CP) — Magistrate W. S. Gardner said Tuesday he is "tired" of listening to parents who take the stand as character witnesses and call children who get into trouble "ideal boys."

He made the comments when he fined William McDonald, 17, of Timmins \$75 and costs on a

charge of assaulting 16-year-old Maurice Bourdon. Bourdon said he was kicked in the head and face at a high school dance because his girl friend refused to dance with McDonald.

McDonald's father, Ross, told the court his son was a "very good boy."

Said Magistrate Gardner: "I'm getting tired of that kind of evidence. Parents are protecting their children too much with that sort of evidence and it is one of the main reasons why there are so many cases of this sort in court today. A fine re-

gain by breaking off your friendship with Bill? Absolutely nothing; so accept it on the terms offered you.

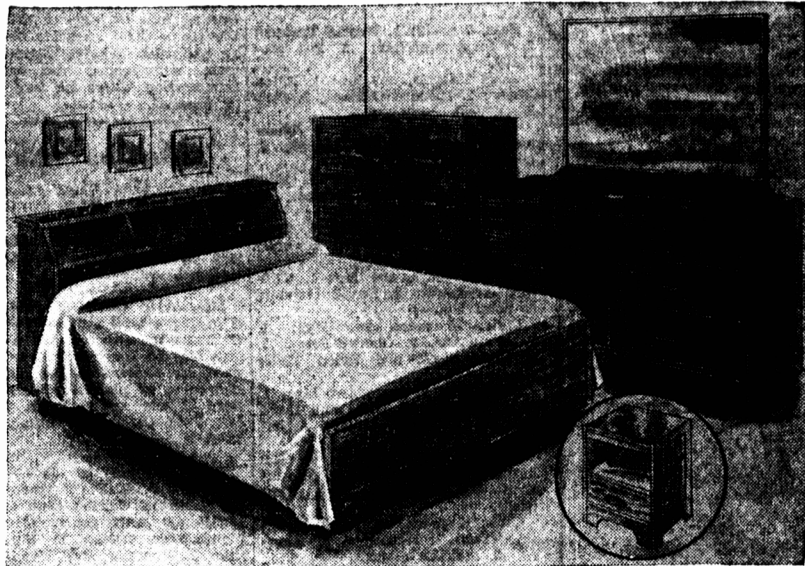
DEAR MISS DIX: I am employed in an office as a stenographer,

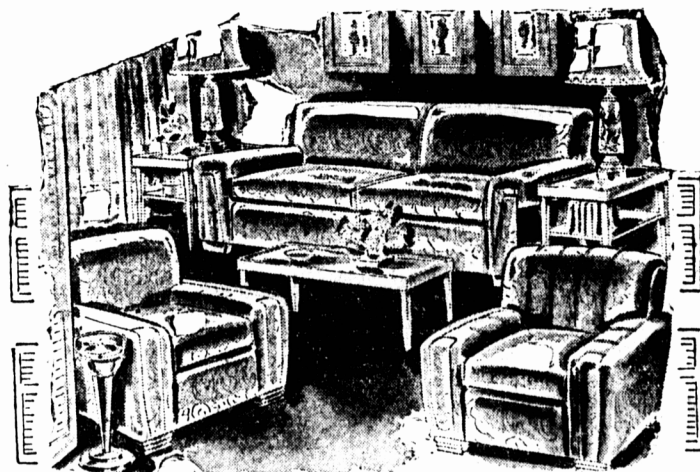

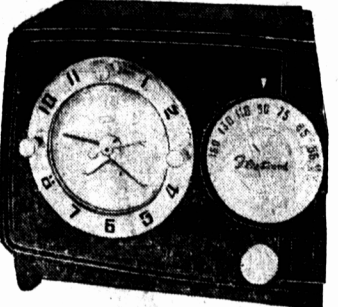

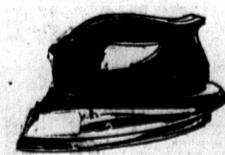
