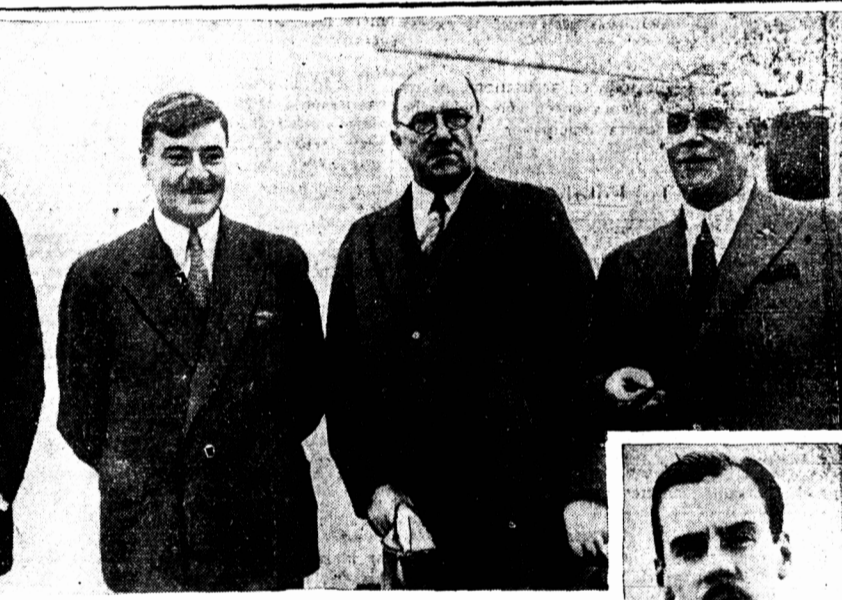
Lord Tweedsmuir Receives Message From King Edward
