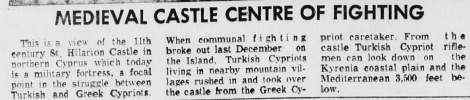

Roosevelt Brothers Varied in Politics

 WASHINGTON, April 29.—Two heirs to the political legacy of Franklin D. Roosevelt are putting the same back on the ballot, another is working for President Johnson—and the fourth is ready to vote again for a Republican for the office his Democratic father once held.

That's an election-year political capsule on the four Roosevelt brothers—a congressman, an assistant to the Democratic national committee, a sub-parliamentary officer and a Republican businessman.

John Roosevelt is the Republican member of the New Deal's first family. He is backing New York Gov. Nelson A. Rockefeller for the Republican presidential nomination.

James is the congressman, a Democrat and an oddson favorite to win his sixth House of Representatives term from California's 26th congressional district.

Elliott is stamping Florida, seeking to become Democratic national committeeman. He is one of 15 candidates for the post in a May 26 election.

Franklin Jr. is No. 2 man in the commerce department—and has put in some time as a Johnson campaigner on the Democratic banner circuit.

He could be headed for the Johnson administration into a new political career—and there's even been a little talk of a Johnson-Roosevelt ticket next November.

That's a long shot, but men who know Roosevelt say he may have his eye on a bid for the New York governorship two years from now.

CERTAIN TO WIN

James Roosevelt, unopposed for re-nomination in his Los Angeles area district, is rated virtually certain to win another House term. The Democrats hold a 2-to-1 registration edge there.

This Roosevelt has dropped, at least temporarily, hopes of moving on to the Senate. After failing to win the endorsement of the powerful California Democratic Council in a bid for the Senate nomination, he withdrew from that race last February.

Elliott Roosevelt, 53, moved to Florida 15 months ago and quickly jumped into Democratic politics.

"I've been a lifelong Democrat and I want to serve the party in the best way I can," he said in declaring his candidacy for national committeeman.

Brother John, who has backed Republican presidential candidates since 1952, indicates he will do the same thing this year, no matter who is nominated.

John, 48, once stamped for his father, but joined the Republican camp to support former president Dwight D. Eisenhower.

When communal fighting broke out last December on the Island, Turkish Cypriots living in nearby mountain villages rushed in and took over the castle from the Greek Cypriot caretaker. Roosevelt — campaigning in his first election venture — argues he knows the inside of Washington, is on a first-name basis with some of the capital's top officials and can win Florida more of the federal dollar.

Kennedy won and named Roosevelt a deputy secretary of commerce.

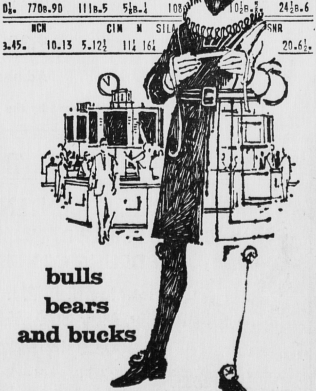
Among Roosevelt's best talks: Direction of the administration's effort to bring new economic life to the depressed areas of the eight-state Appalachian mountain region.

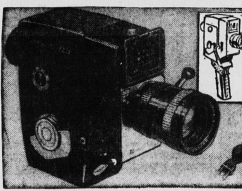
